Ideally, your baby will room in with you 24 hours a day. During this time, one nurse will care for you and your newborn and give you both personalized instruction in all areas of infant care. Couplet care time is very important in preparing you to care for your new baby at home.

Single Room Maternity Care

At Wooster Community Hospital there is no greater joy than bringing a new life into the world. You will receive the finest medical care available, in a setting as comfortable as your own home. The design of Wooster's Women's Pavilion makes it possible for you to labor, deliver, recover, and care for your baby in the same room. Your room has been designed with safety, comfort, privacy, and family in mind.



The father or support person may visit and participate in all aspects of childbirth and baby care, 24 hours a day.

Our specially qualified obstetrical health care team offers individualized and comprehensive consultation. Throughout the delivery process, advanced fetal and maternal monitoring equipment is used to care for both baby and mother.



To help ease the transition into parenthood, we offer classes to expecting parents on childbirth preparation and newborn care.

Healthy siblings may come and greet their new family member with the supervision of an adult. Other friends and family may visit providing they are free of any infectious illness, **from 10:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.**

A tour of the Women's Pavilion can be arranged by appointment with the Prenatal Education Staff. This is a good time to complete necessary Pre-admission paperwork.

Childbirth Preparation

We offer a four-week childbirth preparation series taught by nurses who work in the Obstetrics Department. They will introduce you and your support person to all of the options available during labor and delivery.

Our classes include:

- Relaxation and Breathing Techniques
- Role of support person
- Anesthesia options
- Tour of the OB Department and completion of necessary paperwork
- Discussion about the delivery experience:
 - Vaginal and Cesarean Section
 - Post Partum Care
- Bathing your baby
- Baby safety
- Breast/bottle feeding
